He said when Newton discovered the law of gravity it was in his own mind how to discover it, no one teach him .He discovered it himself by his own soul for knowledge and his own willpower.

The outsiders only suggest us its up to us how will do that we learn all the things by ourselves. He said our mind is like a library of the universe, the world gave us the suggestions and we will do that things by ourselves.

The man rearrange all the previous things in his own mind and make a new thing or ideas in his own way which is own or new. Swami Vivekananda realized three things are necessary to make every man great, every Nation great-

1. Conviction of the powers of goodness.

- 2. Absence of jealousy and suspicion

According to him education is a continuous process; it should cover all aspects of life physical, material, intellectual, emotional, moral and spiritual. His Educational Philosophy is based on his journal life Vivekananda considers education as a part of human life. Real education is that which one can stand on one's feet . Education must make a man conscious of his hidden power.

ACCORDING TO VIVEKANANDA AIMS OF EDUCATION

1. Reaching perfection – Vivekananda's opinioned that all material and spiritual knowledge is already present in man covered by curtain of ignorance. Education should tear off the veil so that the knowledge shines forth and illuminating torch to enliven all the corner by and by.

2. Fulfillment of swadharma (developing self confidence enlightment, self-control, self reverence through education)- According to Swami Ji everyone has to grow like himself herself no one has to copy other two improvement is self inspired. There should not be any type of external pressure on the children. Vivekananda suggest "If you don't allow one to become a lion he become a fox".

3. Unity in diversity (developing participation in democracy)- The true aim of education is to develop insight into the individual so that they become able to search out and realize unity in diversity. Vivekananda said that physical and spiritual worlds are one; they are distinctness is an illusion. Education must be capable of developing this sense which find unity in diversity.



4. Character formation through education- Character is the aggregate of a man's standing and see the sum total of the bent of his mind. We are what our thoughts have made us. It is therefore that education should aim at some sublimating the evil tendencies of our mind.

5. Physical and mental growth (full growth of men either physically or mentally)- One of the important aim of education with physical and mental development of child so that the child, after completing his her education can become able to promote National growth and advancement as a Fearless and a physically well developed citizen of tomorrow.

6. Moral and spiritual development (opening eye of knowledge through education)-According to Vivekananda a nations greatness is not only measured by its parliamentary Institution and activities but also by greatness of its citizens. But the greatness of citizen is possible only through their moral and spiritual development which education should Foster.

7. Religious development(growing faith anf consciousness towards religious through education)-According to Swami Ji religious development is an essential aim of education to him each individual should be able to search out and develop the religious seeds embodied in him this will and this will help in finding out the absolute truth or reality. Hence he advocated the training of feelings and emotions so that the whole life is purified and sublimated.

8. Develop self continents confidence through education- An individual may have many qualities within himself without being conscious of the same it is a function of education to make him conscious of the same.

9. To set up peace in National and international level by educational curriculum- There is no need to teach peace education by seperate subject or elective subject. It should be teach to student as a core subject it aware all the students toward state society Nation and globalization. Now it is must to every child in not only India but also all over world.

10. **Towards nature** -We all are bound with nature starting to end of a life only education make a man social man and transferred our culture to new generation with a good combination of natural environment and earth we will get peace .
